What is the purpose of a grade?

The purpose of a grade is to communicate to students, teachers and parents an accurate report of what students know and can do in relation to an academic standard.

WHAT GOES INTO THE GRADEBOOK?

15% of FINAL GRADE:

FORMATIVE ASSESSMENTS & Assignments

A formative assessment is a quick check for understanding or an opportunity to practice a skill prior to a summative assessment. These assessments help our teachers improve instruction and provide student feedback.

85% of FINAL GRADE:

SUMMATIVE ASSESSMENTS

Final or major assessments used as an opportunity for students to demonstrate their acquired knowledge or the performance of a skill commonly at the end of a unit of study.



LATE WORK?

No reductions on scores for late work. Chronic late work will result in behavioral consequences.



RETAKES ON FINAL ASSESSMENTS?

Students are allowed retakes on summative assessment with evidence of efforts to improve. Students will reassess when receiving 65% or lower on summative.



EXTRA CREDIT IS NOT OFFERED

Only work that shows student learning goes into the gradebook
