Students who are enrolled in Basic Skills courses should register for the afternoon enrichment classes.

Unless otherwise noted, fees are not due until notification of confirmation of enrollment. <u>If fees are requested</u>, checks should be written to "River Falls School District" and submitted to your school office secretary.

NOTICE regarding REFUNDS:

Supplies are purchased early and reservations are made in advance. If you are dropping a class and have paid a fee, you must notify us at least **two weeks** before the start date of the class in order to receive a refund. In some cases, there will be no refund if a student is not found to fill that space in a class or field trip.






WHAT'S COOKING?

OOEY, GOOEY CHEMISTRY



Instructor: Becky Cunningham Grades: 1-2-3-4-5th graders Location: Westside Elementary




