Wild Food Rambles **Friday, May 11th at 6-7:30PM** **Located at St. Croix Picnic Area**

Discover a delightful variety of foods and folk medicine that can be gathered from the wild, and in your own backyard. Though we won't be harvesting wild foods from the Park, we'll talk about safe harvesting practices and how you can pick and prepare wild foods at home. This class will meet rain or shine (unless there are considerable winds and/or lightning.)

Sketch your favorites that you find along the way and learn fun facts about each one we find. There will be field guides provided for you to borrow to help identify flowers as we go.

Falcons of the Driftless **Saturday, July 28th at 11AM-12PM** **Located at St. Croix Picnic Area**

This will be a great "all ages" opportunity to learn about these amazing native birds. Children are welcome, and don't forget your camera! How fast can a falcon fly? What makes them different from an owl or an eagle? What does it take to become a falconer? Bring your questions and curiosity about raptors!
