Individual items for personal use—please **label** these with your child's name

- Backpack (please label with your child's name)
- **Soft**, zippered pencil pouch (large enough to hold 10 pencils, scissors, a pencil sharpener and an eraser). The **flat** zippered kind is ideal. (please label with your child's name)
- Pair of scissors (please label with your child's name)
- 1 composition notebook with a color or design (for Creative writing)
- 1 plastic pocket folder with prongs (please label with your child's name)
- 1 package of modeling clay
- 1 tub of air dry clay
- Gym shoes (required for gym, nice if can be left at school-- please label with your child's name)
- Large paint shirt (like an old adult XL tee-shirt)—to keep in locker (please label)
- Extra set of clothes—to keep in locker for wet playground days, spills, etc. (please label)
- Recommended: comfy hard-bottomed indoor shoes to leave at school (especially winter months)
- New students: bring a mug* for classroom use (not a family heirloom, though)

Consumable Community Supplies (will be shared):

All Students please bring:

- 1 white, 1/2-inch 3-ring binder with the plastic see-through sleeve on the cover (not the soft kind, please) for school/home communication binder
- 2 packs of **Ticonderoga #2 pencils** (Ticonderogas are more expensive, but worth it. They sharpen well and last longer. No decorated pencils please!)
- 1 box of **24-color** colored pencils (24-color rather than 12-color because we need the wider color variety)
- 1 pkg fine-tipped black dry-erase markers
- 1 pkg of plastic sheet protectors
- 1 bottle of glue and 1 package of glue sticks
- 1 pkg of large pink erasers
- 1 package black Sharpie markers
- 1 skein of **thick** yarn or rainbow yarn
- 1 large tissue box

Plus the following community supplies by your child's age level:

1st graders only ("Alphas") please send in:

- 1 **Primary** notebook (cardboard cover, primary-ruled for handwriting)
- 1 white, 1½ -inch 3-ring binder with the plastic see-through sleeve on the cover (not the soft kind)
- 1 pkg 3M sponges (the yellow sponges with the green scrubber side)
- 1 box of **sandwich**-sized ziploc type bags

2nd graders only ("Betas") please send in:

- 3 regular composition notebooks (cardboard covers, **wide**-ruled): Please try to find:
1 blue (for language), 1 green or yellow (for geography and history), 1 red (for science and geometry)
- 1 box of **quart**-sized ziploc type bags

3rd graders only ("Gammas") please send in:

- 3 regular composition notebooks (cardboard covers, **wide**-ruled): Please try to find:
1 blue (for language), 1 green or yellow (for geography and history), 1 red (for science)
- 1 pkg of copy paper
- 1 box of **gallon**-sized ziploc type bags

Art supplies for community use (if you can find, we are grateful, but are not required):

- Prang watercolor paint set
- Chalk pastel crayons or oil pastel crayons
- tapestry or darning needles
