Orientation Day is for students and parents to gain a better understanding of how the 2019-20 school year will unfold. It is a time for communication, answers to your questions, and setting the tone for the year. This year parents will be setting up a 20 minute conference with their child's teacher/s. During this time, teachers will meet with the parents and the child to discuss the upcoming school year. New students to the classroom will have a chance to become acquainted with his/her teacher and environment, and returning students will have a chance to become reacquainted. Parents will have a chance to express any concerns or desires for the upcoming school year, and they will receive registration information that will need to be turned into the gym before leaving the school.

What to Bring With You on September 3rd

1. Payment (check or cash) for lunch account.
2. Current contact information including home address, work and home phone, cell phone and email address.
3. Emergency contact information including:
 - a. Names and phone numbers of two people to contact if we can't reach you.
 - b. Medical and health information as well as prescription information.
4. Legal documents including divorce decrees, custody documents, family court issuances. These will be kept confidential and locked but are necessary if you have special arrangements.
5. All school supplies.
6. Completed Free and Reduced Lunch forms to be turned in to the office.
7. Immunization records for Kindergarten students and updates for older students if applicable.
