Welcome to Summer School 2018!

This booklet contains a listing of the 2018 Elementary Summer School Enrichment courses. Classes will be held at **Greenwood Elementary** unless otherwise noted. Classes will run Monday through Thursday. **No classes July 4 – 5.**

For classes with limited enrollment, registrations will be taken on a first come—first served basis. If sufficient enrollment is received, additional sessions may be added. Check carefully and do not register your child for classes that have overlapping times or dates.

Grade levels listed are for the grade your child will enter in the fall of 2018. Early registration would be appreciated and is encouraged.

Final registration deadline is Friday, April 13, 2018.

Students who are enrolled in Basic Skills courses should register for the afternoon enrichment classes.

FEES: Unless otherwise noted, fees are not due until notification of confirmation of enrollment. If fees are requested, checks should be written to “River Falls School District” and submitted to your school office secretary. **INCLUDE student’s name and the name of the class you are paying for—to ensure the payment is credited to the correct account.**

NOTICE regarding REFUNDS:

Supplies are purchased early and reservations are made in advance. If you are dropping a class and have paid a fee, you must notify us at least **two weeks** before the start date of the class in order to receive a refund. In some cases, there will be no refund if a student is not found to fill that space in a class or field trip.

In late April or by May 2, **you will receive an e-mail notification** to confirm or deny your child’s official enrollment in a class. For this purpose, **PLEASE include your e-mail address on the registration form.**

Grades: 3-4

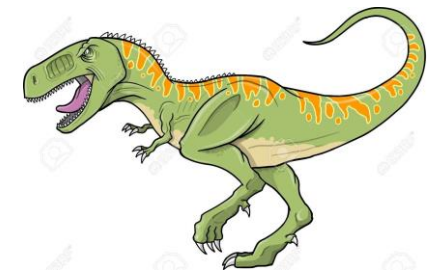
Location: Greenwood Elementary

Grades: K-1-2-3

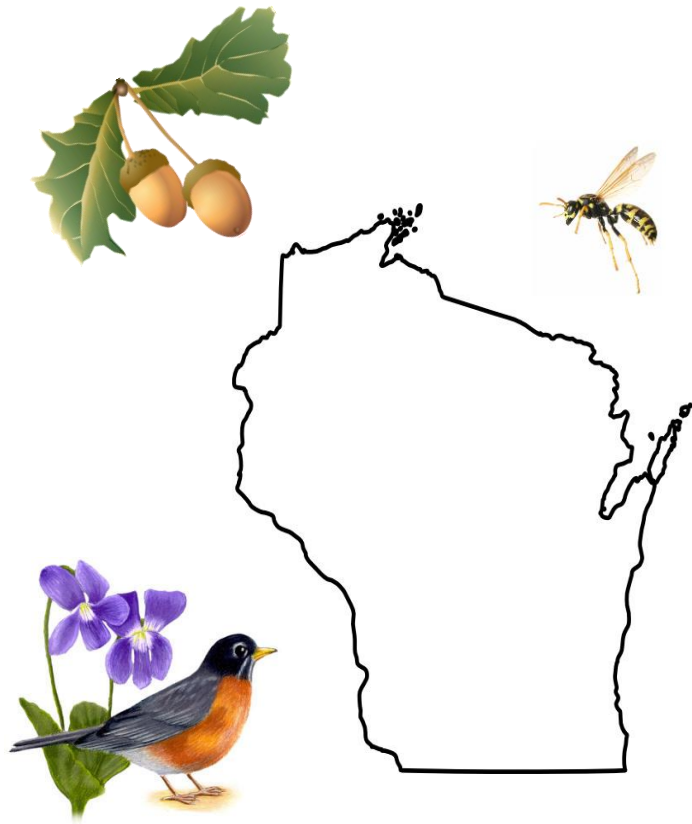
Location: Greenwood Elementary

Location: Greenwood Elementary

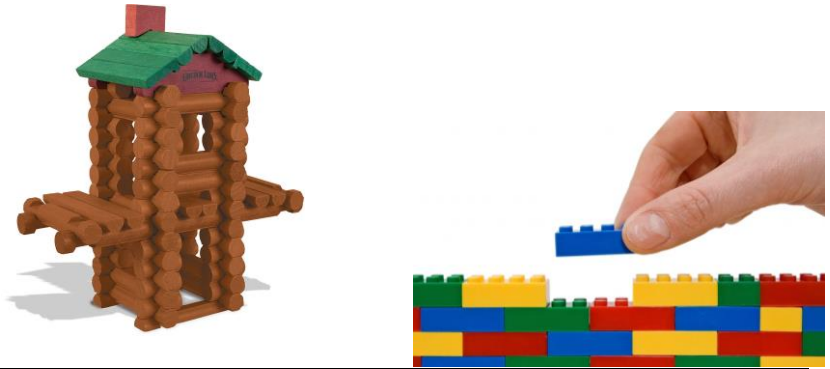

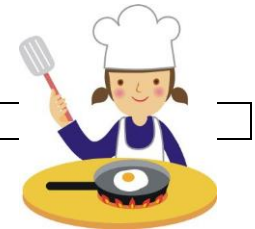
