

# Ms. Maggie's Class Supply List—2014-15

**Individual**—please label these with your child's name

- Soft, zippered pencil pouch (large enough to hold two pencils, some colored pencils, a pencil sharpener, and an eraser)
- 1 small pencil sharpener
- Backpack
- Gym shoes (required for gym, nice if can be left at school)
- Large paint shirt (like an old adult XL tee-shirt)—to keep in locker
- Extra set of clothes—to keep in locker
- Recommended: comfy hard-bottomed indoor shoes to leave at school (especially winter months)

**Consumable Community Supplies—All Students:**

- 2 folders with prongs in the middle (no decorated folders, please)
- 2 pkgs wide ruled loose-leaf paper
- 2 packs of **Ticonderoga #2 pencils**, sharpened (Ticonderogas are more expensive, but worth it. They sharpen well and last longer. If another brand, please send 5 boxes. No decorated pencils please!)
- 1 pkg of large erasers
- 1 pkg of pencil-cap erasers
- 1 box of 24-color colored pencils (or 2 boxes of 12-color colored pencils)
- 1 box of **red** pencils
- 1 bottle of glue
- 1 pkg of plastic sheet protectors
- 1 skein of **thick** yarn

**Alphas only:**

- 1 white, 1-inch 3-ring binder (not the soft kind, please)
- 2 **wide-ruled** notebooks (no decorated covers please)
- 1 pkg 3M sponges (the yellow sponges with the green scrubber side)
- 1 box of **sandwich**-sized ziploc type bags

**Betas only:**

- 1 **5-subject wide-ruled** spiral bound notebook (no decorated covers please)
- 1 large bottle of dishwashing soap
- 1 box of **quart**-sized ziploc type bags
- 1 pkg of copy paper

**Gammas only:**

- 1 graph paper notebook or composition book (4 squares per inch grid or quadrille)
- 1 **5-subject** spiral bound notebook (no decorated covers please)
- A protractor/compass/set square kit
- 1 box of **gallon**-sized ziploc type bags

**Things we can always use if you run across at garage sales, etc.**

- Small fabric remnants, grosgrain ribbon, yarn, embroidery thread
- Knitting needles, crochet needles, tapestry or darning needles
- Neat items from nature or your own travels
- Books: especially nature, atlases, world maps
